PLEASE NOTE: Our membership year is from September 1st to August 31st and not based on the calendar year.

NEW ACTIVE MEMBERS: Dues are \$150 per membership year. For those who join in the last half of our membership year (i.e., March to August), the fee is reduced to \$75. HPCA will provide a link to your Web site from the HPCA online directory at no cost.

RETURNING ACTIVE MEMBERS: Dues are \$125 per membership year for renewals.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERS: Dues are \$75 per membership year. **STUDENT MEMBERS:** Dues are \$50 per membership year.

Associate and Student memberships entitle you to receive *HomeWork* and access to the Internet mailing list, but not a page in the HPCA online directory.
